## Flying Dragon Clean Boost

Your new 'Dragon can be used in a number of ways, all giving slightly different results to help you achieve the sound you've been chasing.

Placing the 'Dragon first in the chain and set to unity or slightly above (about 10 o'clock on the knob), left on all the time, and the 'Dragon will act as a superb line driver/buffer to help push the signal through long cable chains as well as fattening up the sound some, especially for single coil guitars.

Placing the 'Dragon last in the signal chain directly before the amp can be utilized two ways:

- ❖ similar to the method above, leave the 'Dragon on all the time set at or slightly above unity to restore your signal fidelity and help drive the signal to the amp
- ❖ set the level to taste (start at noon and tweak to taste) for a pure lead/solo boost. If your amp is set clean, with a lot of headroom left, then you will get a straight volume boost. If the amp is set on the edge of breakup, the 'Dragon will push your amp over, and beyond, depending on how much gain is dialed into the pedal

Placing the 'Dragon before your overdrive will boost the signal into the overdrive which can help create smooth overdriven tones. If you love the sound of your overdrive but wish it just had a little more oomph, try the 'Dragon here. Set at about noon on the knob and dial in to taste.

Placing the 'Dragon after your overdrive will take the overdriven sound you already have and boost it, with no change in the tone or sound. If you love the sound of your overdrive, and just wish you could make it louder without changing the tone or sound, try the 'Dragon here.

No matter where you place the 'Dragon, the same concepts of a clean vs. a dirty amp apply. If your amp is set clean with a lot of headroom left, then the 'Dragon will keep your signal clean. If the amp is setup on the edge of breakup, boosting the signal will act more as a light overdrive than a straight volume boost. If your amp is set dirty and you are looking for a pure volume boost, try placing the 'Dragon in the effects loop, if available.



Only use a 9V center negative power supply for your new Flying Dragon. Any standard pedal power supply (regulated and filtered) that is center negative will work as the Flying Dragon draws less than 4mA.
